7. Guidance Notes

Who Can Benefit?

A young person up to 21 years of age, who fulfils the following:

- (1) a resident in Green Street Green (see map attached)*
- (2) someone, or a dependant of someone, who is suffering financial hardship
- * an applicant just outside the area shown on the map may be considered at the discretion of the Trustees

When completing the application form, please do so as fully as possible, and importantly, including any letters of support from relevant persons, such as sports trainers, music teachers, doctors.

Types of Grants Awarded

The Trustees may use the Trust income for any purpose which promotes its objects, as laid down in its Constitution:

"To promote for the benefit of the inhabitants of Green Street Green and the surrounding area the provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interests of social welfare and with the object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants."

The following are examples of eligible grants:

- (1) Towards extra-curricular recreational courses for young people;
- (2) To enable a young person on leaving school, college etc to continue with sports or musical activities.

General Principles which the Trustees have adopted

The application of Trust Income has been broadly described in the above section. All applicants are strongly advised to note the general principles the Trustees use in awarding grants. They are as follows:

- 1. The Trustees are inclined to apply the Trust income to exceptional or extraordinary cases of hardship or circumstances.
- 2. The Trustees will generally favour an application which is below £250 and where the applicant has not previously received a grant.
- 3. The Trustees will want to be satisfied that the person is in need of financial support which is not available from other sources.
- 4. The Trustees will be encouraged to give grants if applicants have made an effort to raise finances themselves.
- 5. The Trustees will always be helped to reach a decision on grants for young people by evidence from a Tutor/Coach/Teacher of special aptitude or proficiency.

Data Protection Policy

Only the Trustees will have access to your personal data and will not release it to anyone else. If you wish your data to be released to other parties, you must consent to this. If you wish us to provide information to someone such as a bank you should contact us to give your consent, either directly or through the third party requesting the data, or you should ensure that you pass the third party request to us yourself.

Application forms will be destroyed immediately if a grant is not awarded and after the end of the financial year in which any grant is awarded. No personal data will be retained.
